

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1999 Elderly Program Donations)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-232

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the
2 elderly members of the Nation; and

3 WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been made possible
4 in part by the Older Americans Act of 1965 as amended; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Older Americans
6 Act Title III and Title VI Programs; and

7 WHEREAS, the Older American's Act, provides that Elders may make contributions to
8 the program during the congregate meals; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation feels it is in their best interest to waive the
10 contributions policies of the Older American's Act.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby waive
12 the donation policies of the Older American's Act in order to ensure all
13 elders receive nutrition services at no cost.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day
15 of MAY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0-
16 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the
17 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,
18 adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the
19 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
20 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
