4		O'odham Charitable Organization (OCO) on the reservation"; and
5	WHEREAS,	Resolution 98-374 was passed on September 21, 1998 establishing the
6		O'odham Charitable Office and an Operational Budget of \$220,138.75 and
7		Confirming the Appointment of an Interim Advisory Board; and
8	WHEREAS,	Resolution No. 99-188 was passed on April 19, 1999 amending Resolution
9		No. 98-374, "Approving the Establishment of an O'odham Charitable
10		Office and an Operational Budget of \$220,138.75 and Confirming the
11		Appointment of an Interim Advisory Board" to reinstate the District
12		Chairpersons of the eleven Districts to continue to discharge the duties of
13		the office, until the May 1999 General Session of the Legislative Council;
14		and
15	WHEREAS,	on May 06, 1999, a quorum of seven interim members of the Advisory
16		Board met together with the Vice Chairman of the Nation and the Rules
17		Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and reviewed the
18		proposed amendment; and
19	WHEREAS,	it has been determined that amendments be made to Resolution No. 98-374,
20		Sections 2B, Appointment and Representation, to "No individual may hold
21		an elected office within the governing bodies of the Nation," is being

deleted, and 2C, Term of Office, changes from "The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council shall determine which members shall serve two year terms and which members shall serve three year terms" to "The Vice Chairman of the Nation and the Rules Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council together shall determine which members shall serve two year terms and three year terms", and 2G, Remuneration, changes from "No member of the Advisory Board shall receive remuneration for services rendered in the capacity of an Advisory Board member," to "Members of the Advisory Board shall receive remuneration in the form of \$75.00 per diem and .32 mileage expenses or the current mileage rate of the Nation, and costs are to be paid from the O'odham Charitable Office administrative operational budget"; and

WHEREAS, the power of implementation is vested in the Office of the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation by the Nation's Constitution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 98-374 hereby amends the following subsections:

2B. Appointment and Representation. "Each District may recommend one individual for representation on the O'odham Charitable Advisory Board. All prospective Board members must meet all Board membership requirements. Candidates recommended by the Districts for the initial Board shall be reviewed by the Vice Chairman of the Nation together with the Rules Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, and qualified candidates shall be appointed by
