RESOLUTION NO. 99-237

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is dedicated to the development of improved**
2 **long range planning for land use and development of the Nation's social**
3 **and economic resources for the betterment of the Nation's people and their**
4 **future; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, the Land Use Planning project is the best first step in the process of**
6 **improving the Nation's options for a well planned future; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, this opportunity has been brought before the Districts of the Nation for**
8 **their information and approval; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, the Districts of the Nation have requested by resolution the Nation**
10 **authorize the Administration for Native Americans grant proposal for Land**
11 **Use Planning; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, the Administration for Native Americans has a grant opportunity to fund**
13 **the Nation's Land Use Planning project in the 1999 funding cycle; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, the Nation, through its people, its Chairman and its Legislative Council**
15 **has mandated a need for this proposed land use plan in the peoples**
16 **consensus on and the Legislative Council's acceptance and adoption of the**
17 **Chairman's Administrative Plan under Resolution No. 97-082, with regard**
18 **to land use planning; and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, the Land Use Planning project will be a two year project in the amount of**
20 **\$244,261.00 for the first year and \$243,107.00 for the second year - a total of**
21 **\$487,368.00; and**

- 11 3. **The Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation;**
- 12 4. **The Tohono O'odham Nation Office of the Attorney General;**
- 13 5. **The Village Representatives from each of the communities of the**
14 **Tohono O'odham Nation;**
- 15 6. **The Indian Health Service agency;**
- 16 7. **The Tohono O'odham Utility Authority;**
- 17 8. **The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council;**
- 18 9. **The Tohono O'odham Natural Resources Department;**
- 19 10. **The Tohono O'odham Enrollment Office; and**
- 20 11. **The Bureau of Indian Affairs.**
