1 WHEREAS, A'al We:pek provides year round support groups and cultural education
2 for children and interested tribal members; and

3 WHEREAS, the children learn about the disease of alcohol and drug addiction and
4 how it effects all family members; and

5 WHEREAS, alcohol and drug use is a tremendous problem in our communities and
6 must be actively addressed; and

7 WHEREAS, donated funds will be utilized to send family members to intensive
8 workshops which address specific personal and family addiction issues;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, community workshops will also be provided to increase community
11 awareness of the disease of alcoholism and drug addiction and the
12 effects it has on children; and

13 WHEREAS, it will generate ideas of community support to help our children; and

14 WHEREAS, to further create awareness of the organization funds will also be utilized
15 to purchase give-a-ways such as pens, pins, keychains, etc.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
17 approves the donation request of \$33,320 to A'al We:pek/Children First.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds will be appropriated from the General
19 Revenue.
