

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting Cultural Affairs Office Supplemental Budget Modification #1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-315**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has provided budget support for**  
2 **the Cultural Affairs Office and the Tohono O'odham Cultural**  
3 **Center/Museum Committee to plan and design a Cultural**  
4 **Center/Museum for the Tohono O'odham Nation for the past two fiscal**  
5 **years; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the efforts of the**  
7 **Cultural Center Museum Committee and Cultural Affairs Office to locate**  
8 **a physical site for the Nation's Cultural Center/Museum; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the efforts of the**  
10 **Cultural Center Committee and Cultural Affairs Office to adequately**  
11 **study the suitability of the three proposed sites.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
13 **supports the proposal from the Cultural Affairs Office and Cultural**  
14 **Center/Museum Committee to use Supplemental Budget Funds of**  
15 **\$30,385.37 previously allocated under Professional Services (810) for a**  
16 **full-time Grant Writer, instead to be used under Professional Services**  
17 **(810) to issue an RFP or RFQ for a Site Analysis Study of Three Proposed**  
18 **Sites for the Tohono O'odham Nation's Cultural Center/Museum.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 08TH day**  
20 **of JUNE, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR;**  
21 **0 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in**  
22 **the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**  
23 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by**  
24 **the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,**  
25 **pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
