

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Tohono**  
**O'odham Nation and the City of Tucson)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-325**

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation will enter an agreement with the City of**  
2                   **Tucson, Arizona Human Resource Department for user-agency agreement**  
3                   **for employment purposes under the Welfare to Work Program; and**

4   **WHEREAS, the designated service delivery area for the Tohono O'odham Nation,**  
5                   **JTPA/NEW Program is defined as residing within the boundaries of the**  
6                   **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

7   **WHEREAS, entry level positions will become available throughout the City of Tucson**  
8                   **under concurrent Human Resource policies for the Welfare to Work**  
9                   **Program and the City of Tucson; and**

10   **WHEREAS, the intent and spirit of this agreement is to enhance and provide**  
11                   **significant and meaningful work experiences to our Tohono O'odham**  
12                   **members through practical learning and "hands on" approach techniques,**  
13                   **in a professional environment; and**

14   **WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement, herein, shall not be construed as an**  
15                   **expressed or implied waiver of the Tohono O'odham Nation's sovereign**  
16                   **immunity.**

17   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
18                   **that it hereby approves the Memorandum of Agreement between the**  
19                   **Tohono O'odham Nation and the City of Tucson.**

20   **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**  
21                   **Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any**  
22                   **designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the**

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1 contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or  
2 funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior  
3 approval by this Council.


4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 09TH day  
5 of JUNE, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,101.45 FOR;  
6 -0- AGAINST; 64.05 NOT VOTING; and [0] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested  
7 in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham  
8 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by  
9 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
10 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

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


