RESOLUTION NO. 99-340

1 **WHEREAS, Richard Brown is a member of the Tohono O'odham Nation of the**
2 **Baboquivari District; and**

3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Brown is currently employed with the Indian Oasis School District**
4 **for the past one and a half years (1 1/2) as a Health and Physical Education**
5 **Teacher and Cross Country/Track Coach at Topawa Intermediate and**
6 **Baboquivari High Schools; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Mr. Brown is actively involved in competing in different marathons**
8 **throughout the United States; and**

9 **WHEREAS, in December of 1998, Mr. Brown qualified for the 2000 Men's Marathon**
10 **Trial to be held in Pittsburgh, PA in May 2000; and**

11 **WHEREAS, Mr. Brown has requested a one year leave of absence to prepare for the**
12 **upcoming 2000 Olympic Games to be held in Sydney, Australia; and**

13 **WHEREAS, he is requesting assisting from the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue**
14 **his quest to qualify for the United States Olympic Team; and**

15 **WHEREAS, being a member of the Tohono O'odham Nation it is an honor to have a**
16 **member participate in a worldwide athletic competition which represents**
17 **Nation's across the world; and**

18 **WHEREAS, attached is a budget request of monthly expenses needed to prepare him**
19 **for the 2000 Olympic Games.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
21 **hereby supports and approves the amount of \$30,000 to Richard Brown in**
22 **his quest to compete in the 2000 Olympic Games in Sydney, Australia.**

7 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by
8 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
9 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
