1   **WHEREAS, A'al We:pek provides year round support groups and cultural education**  
2                   **for children and interested tribal members; and**

3   **WHEREAS, the children learn about the disease of alcohol and drug addiction and**  
4                   **how it effects all family members; and**

5   **WHEREAS, alcohol and drug use is a tremendous problem in our communities and**  
6                   **must be actively addressed; and**

7   **WHEREAS, donated funds will be utilized to send family members to intensive**  
8                   **workshops which address specific personal and family addiction issues;**  
9                   **and**

10   **WHEREAS, community workshops will also be provided to increase community**  
11                   **awareness of the disease of alcoholism and drug addiction and the effects**  
12                   **it has on children; and**

13   **WHEREAS, it will generate ideas of community support to help our children; and**

14   **WHEREAS, to further create awareness of the organization funds will also be utilized**  
15                   **to purchase give-a-ways such as pens, pins, keychains, etc.**

16   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
17                   **approves the donation request of \$33,320 to A'al We:pek/Children First.**

18   **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$33,320.00 are hereby**  
19                   **appropriated from the FY 1998 savings.**

20   **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 11TH day**  
21   **of JUNE, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,422.25 FOR;**  
22   **523.95 AGAINST; 219.3 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers**  
23   **vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono**


