

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Submission and Negotiation of an Indian Self-Determination  
Act Master Contract and Fiscal Year 2000 Annual Funding Agreement with  
the UNITED STATES GEOLOGICAL SURVEY)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-345**

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation desires to contract from the United States  
2 Geological Survey the performance of a comprehensive assessment of the  
3 hydrologic conditions, both present and future, within the area which is  
4 contiguous to the International Boundary between the Nation's lands and  
5 the Republic of Mexico and which is approximately sixty-one (61) miles  
6 long (east to west) and twenty five (25) miles north fro the full 61-mile  
7 length from the International Boundary; and

8 WHEREAS, this activity shall include, but not be limited to, monitoring surface water  
9 stream flow in the Vamori, San Simon and other washes selected by the  
10 Nation.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 12 1. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to submit the attached  
13 Master Contract and Fiscal Year 2000 Annual Funding Agreement to  
14 the United States Geological Survey and to negotiate maximum  
15 funding and acceptance by the United States Geological Survey of the  
16 terms and conditions contained therein.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 11TH day  
18 of JUNE, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR;  
19 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in  
20 the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham  
21 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by  
22 the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
23 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
