8 **WHEREAS, this is an opportunity for the Baboquivari High School students to**  
9 **represent the State of Arizona and the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, support and monetary assistance in the amount of \$16,240.00 is being**  
11 **requested for their participation in the 1999 Down Under International**  
12 **Games; and**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative**  
14 **Council supports Guadalupe Rodriquez, Eric Isaac, Allery Antone, Joseph**  
15 **Velasco and Chaperon, Richard Brown's participation in the Down Under**  
16 **International Games and hereby appropriates \$16,240.00 to defray**  
17 **expenses.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Sells District has provided a contribution of \$2,700**  
19 **for expenses for Joseph Velasco.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of \$16,240.00 shall be appropriated from**  
21 **the 1998 Savings Account.**
