1	WHEREAS,	all peoples should be treated with respect, dignity and equality,

4		and symbols serve only to threaten and demean entire groups because of
5		their race, creed or religion; and
6	WHEREAS,	American Indians are a group targeted by the existence and prevalence of
7		American Indian named teams and mascots, stereotypical depictions in
8		logos, and derogatory references in school or team fight songs; and
9	WHEREAS,	such depictions and references insult American Indian tradition, culture
10		and religion; and
11	WHEREAS,	Lynn O'Keefe, a member of the Oglala Lakota Nation, and other
12		American Indians have filed an action pursuant to Title II of the 1964
13		Civil Rights Act against the Cleveland Indians Baseball Club, Inc., and
14		stadium known as Jacob's Field, based on the fact that due to the
15		associative use of Cleveland Indians with the caricature and logo known
16		as Chief Wahoo, all American Indians are denied equal access and
17		enjoyment of the stadium and sports event, and are thus victims of racial
18		and religious discrimination at a public accommodation.
19	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,
20		on behalf of the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation, a federally
