

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Appropriations of \$27,787 in Funds to Develop a Resource  
Management Plan for the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-354**

1 **WHEREAS, the Nation has expended many resources in establishing a Natural**  
2 **Resources Department, a Cultural Preservation Office, an Environmental**  
3 **Protection Office, a Water Projects Office, a Well Maintenance Program,**  
4 **and the Ranger Program, each of these efforts exist somewhat**  
5 **independently and do not follow a coordinated plan; and**

6 **WHEREAS, a resource management plan would identify how the Nation plans to**  
7 **manage its resources and can be used as a template for any land acquired**  
8 **by the Nation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Nation's current resources do not provide for the staff necessary for**  
10 **development of a resource management plan and to receive credibility and**  
11 **support such a plan should be developed by an independent, third-party,**  
12 **academic institution; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Nation has sought assistance from Peter Likins,**  
14 **President of the University of Arizona, and has identified Richard Stoffle,**  
15 **Ph.D., who works in the University of Arizona's Bureau of Applied**  
16 **Research in Anthropology; and**

17 **WHEREAS, University of Arizona's Bureau of Applied Research in Anthropology has**  
18 **a national reputation in the development of resource management plans;**  
19 **and**

20 **WHEREAS, the cost for the development of the Nation's resource management plan has**  
21 **been identified at \$27,787, which includes a waiver of all overhead costs by**  
22 **the University of Arizona.**

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council

2 that:

- 3 1. The amount of \$27,787 is hereby appropriated from the FY 1998 savings  
4 for the purpose of funding the development of a resource management  
5 plan by the University of Arizona's Bureau of Applied Research in  
6 Anthropology.
- 7 2. The Chairman is hereby authorized to enter into and manage a contract  
8 with the University of Arizona for such purposes.

9 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH day  
10 of JUNE, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; 0  
11 AGAINST; 0 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
12 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
13 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
14 approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
15 March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


