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1	WHEREAS,	on June 28, 1997 the voters of the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation")
2		approved Initiative No. IN-01-97 (the "Initiative"); and
3	WHEREAS,	the Initiative authorized funding from Gaming Revenues for several
4		measures, including a one-time per capita distribution of \$2,000 to each
5		member of the Nation enrolled on June 28, 1997 (the "Initial Per Capita
6		Distribution"); and
7	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution 97-451, the Legislative Council adopted an Initiative
8		Funding and Implementation Plan (the "FIP") which authorized the
9		establishment of set-aside accounts for the Initial Per Capita Distribution
10		and other Initiative measures, and set certain conditions on the
11		expenditure of funds from such accounts; and
12	WHEREAS,	by Resolution 97-478, the Legislative Council approved the transfer of funds
13		from the Desert Diamond Savings Account to certain designated set-aside
14		accounts established at Bank of America Arizona, including the sum of \$41.5
15		million to set-aside account no. 3030425-1067524 for the Initial Per Capita
16		Distribution (the "Per Capita Account"); and
17	WHEREAS,	three of the conditions to expenditure of the Per Capita Account specified
18		in the FIP are (1) approval by the Secretary of the Interior of a per capita
19		distribution plan (the "Revenue Allocation Plan") pursuant to the
20		requirements of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C. § 2710 (b) (3);
21		(2) acceptance by the Legislative Council of a Certification of Eligible
22		Members submitted by the Enrollment Office and based upon receipt of a
23		properly completed and filed Certificate of Eligibility Verification for Per
24		Capita Payment for each member; and (3) as to each Minor Eligible Member,

WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution 97-452, the Legislative Council adopted a Revenue					
	Allocation Plan and caused the Plan to be submitted for approval by the					
	Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs in accordance					
	with authority delegated to the Area Office by the Secretary of the Interior;					
	and					
WHEREAS,	by letter dated December 18, 1997, the Area Office approved the Revenue					
	Allocation Plan with respect to the Initial Per Capita Distribution and					
	disapproved the Plan with respect to the Biennial Per Capita Payments; and					
WHEREAS,	an agreement with Bank of America has not yet been finalized for the					
	establishment of the restricted accounts which is required as a condition					
	to disbursement of the Initial Per Capita Distribution to such accounts for					
	Minor Eligible Members; and					
WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution Nos. 97-525, 98-010, 98-037, 98-084, 98-128, 98-192,					
	98-207, 98-278, 98-316, 98-360, 98-431, 98-478, 98-505, 99-006, 99-041, 99-					
	081, 99-142, 99-201, and 99-312 the Legislative Council accepted and					
	approved Certifications of Eligible Members for the Initial Per Capita					
	Distribution, and disbursements have been made to such members; and					
WHIDDEAG	the Envellment Office has filed with the Lagislative Council a Cartification					

of Eligible Members listing 35 adult members who are eligible for receipt of the Initial Per Capita Distribution; and

WHEREAS, all conditions under the laws of the United States and the Nation have been satisfied to permit the disbursement of the Initial Per Capita Distribution to the members listed in the Certification of Eligible members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby accepts and approves the Certification of Eligible Members, in the form attached hereto.
- 2. The Legislative Council authorizes (a) the transfer of the sum of \$70,000.00 from the Per Capita Account to the special checking account no. 252-350-324 established at Bank of America Arizona (the "Per Capita Checking Account"); and (b) upon the joint signature of the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Nation, issuance of a check on the Per Capita Checking Account in the amount of (i) \$2,000 to each Eligible Member residing in the United States and listed in the attached Certification of Eligible Members and (ii) \$1,400 to each Eligible Member residing outside the United States and listed in the attached Certification, with the balance of \$600 withheld and remitted to the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to the requirements of federal law.
- The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to execute such other documents as may be necessary to implement this Resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 13TH. day of <u>IULY</u>, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,862.9</u> FOR; <u>80.0</u> AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 222.6 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(1), (2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
