RESOLUTION NO. 99-369

1 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance (TERO) Commission was**
2 **appropriated a base budget of \$28,532.00 for FY 1999; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the TERO Commission has identified additional needs for FY 1999; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the TERO Commission is requesting that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
5 **Council approve budget Amendment No. 01, which includes two additional**
6 **line items.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**
8 **hereby approves the TERO Commission's FY 99 Budget Amendment No. 01**
9 **in the amount of \$28,532.00.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 13TH, day**
11 **of JULY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,878.85 FOR; -0-**
12 **AGAINST; 64.05 NOT VOTING; and 222.6 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
13 **Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
14 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
15 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**
16 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
