

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 99 Budget Modification #1 Request for the Tohono O'odham
Nation Fire Department)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-383

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation established the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire**
2 **Department in 1995 to provide fire protection and fire safety to all members**
3 **of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department has come before the Tohono**
5 **O'odham Legislative Council and requested approval of a budget modification**
6 **#1 to transfer monies from line item 01-1095-612.00 (Occasional**
7 **Appointments) and be distributed into line item 01-1095-610.00 (salaries) to**
8 **cover anticipated overtime and Occasional Firefighter cost for the remaining**
9 **fiscal year 99; and**

10 **WHEREAS, money from line item 01-1095-610.5 (Other Compensation) to be distributed**
11 **to the following line items: 01-1095-712 (Gas, Oil & Coolant) to compensate for**
12 **the high cost of local Diesel fuel. 01-1095-721 (Supplies Other) for purchasing**
13 **of Class A and B Foam in addition to other firefighting equipment; and**

14 **WHEREAS, 01-1095-810 (Professional Services) for web page design, moving of utilities for**
15 **construction (Bay addition) and the cost for an Architect. 01-1095-778 (Facility**
16 **Maintenance/Renovation) for cost of construction that is anticipated to be**
17 **higher then originally estimated, due to increase in cost per square foot for**
18 **construction; and**

19 **WHEREAS, 01-1095-855 (Consumable) and 01-1095-860 (Special Activities) to cover**
20 **remaining FY 99 for food, Gatorade and water for firefighters.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
22 **recommends the approval of the budget modification #1 request.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 14TH day of**
24 **JULY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,814.8 FOR; -0-**
25 **AGAINST; 128.1 NOT VOTING; and 222.6 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
26 **Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
27 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
28 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**
29 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


