

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Permitting, Safe Ride Services, Inc. to Continue to Provide Non-Emergency
Medically Necessary Transportation Services on the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-390

1 **WHEREAS, Safe Ride Services Inc., a private company, provides non-emergency**
2 **medically necessary transportation services on the Tohono O'odham**
3 **Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Safe Ride Services Inc., has been permitted to provide non-emergency**
5 **Medically necessary transportation services within the Nation by**
6 **resolutions since 1991; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the last resolution, 98-280 has expired on July 14, 1999; and**

8 **WHEREAS, on July 14, 1999, the Legislative Council did consider and defeated a**
9 **proposed resolution to allow Safe Ride Services, Inc. to continue providing**
10 **transportation services on the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, Safe Ride Services, Inc. Management has met with the Legislative Oversight**
12 **Committee and Executive Staff to request permission to continue to provide**
13 **non-emergency Medically necessary transportation service for the Nation;**
14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, after review of Safe Ride Inc., Management request, the Health and Human**
16 **Services Committee and Staff from the Executive Office agree to permit Safe**
17 **Ride Inc. continue the non-emergency Medically necessary transportation**
18 **service on the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council has reviewed and**
20 **approved:**

21 **1. Safe Ride Services, Inc. is authorized and granted permission to provide**
22 **medically necessary transportation services within the Nation for six (6)**
23 **months from the date of enactment of the resolution.**

24 **2. Permission is conditioned upon Safe Ride Services, Inc.'s compliance**
25 **with all laws of the Nation as well as applicable federal and state laws,**
26 **and full cooperation with the Nation and the Indian Health Service..**

- 3. Safe Ride Services Inc. will provide the Health & Human Service Committee, Executive Staff and San Lucy District with written quarterly report or provide the committee with oral report.
- 4. The Legislative Council reserves the right to rescind the resolution with a 30-day notice.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH day of JULY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,782.9 FOR; 160.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 222.6 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
