

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting the Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for American  
Indians with Disabilities, 130 Project, Budget Amendment #1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-399**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is charged with the responsibility**  
2 **of supporting programs in the Tohono O'odham Nation that will benefit all**  
3 **Tohono O'odham; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the newly funded Tohono O'odham Vocational Rehabilitation Program**  
5 **under the Education Department inadvertently failed to include line item**  
6 **712.0 Gas, Oil and Coolants; and**

7 **WHEREAS, line item 712.0 Gas, Oil and Coolants is necessary to maintain Tohono**  
8 **O'odham Vocational Rehabilitation Program vehicles and overall impact**  
9 **on program operations.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
11 **supports the inclusion of line item 712.0, Gas, Oil and Coolants, in Budget**  
12 **Amendment #1 for Tohono O'odham Vocational Rehabilitation Program.**

13 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH. day**  
14 **of JULY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,942.9 FOR; -0-**  
15 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 222.6 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
16 **Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
17 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
18 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
19 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


