

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Solid Waste Management Program Budget Amendment)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-401**

- 1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), in exercise of its sovereign authority,**  
2                   **desires to manage and regulate the storage, collection, recycling,**  
3                   **transportation and disposal of solid waste and certain hazardous waste on**  
4                   **lands within the boundaries of the Nation in order to protect the Nation's**  
5                   **environment, its natural resources, the political integrity and economic**  
6                   **security of the Nation, and the health, safety and welfare of its members and**  
7                   **all persons present on the lands of the Nation; and**
- 8   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Council") adopted the**  
9                   **Solid Waste Management Code and Solid Waste Management Plan on**  
10                  **February 12, 1997 with Resolution No. 97-041; and**
- 11   **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program (Program) of the Natural Resources**  
12                  **Department is now recycling scrap metal, office paper, tires and batteries and**  
13                  **providing solid waste collection to all villages by way of 600 bins placed**  
14                  **throughout the Nation; trucks that collect on an average week 70 tons of solid**  
15                  **waste from the bins, and hauls that waste to landfills located off of the Nation's**  
16                  **lands; and**
- 17   **WHEREAS, the Program needs laborers for clean-up projects at dump sites and surface**  
18                  **dumping areas; and**
- 19   **WHEREAS, the Program has contracted out all heavy truck repair work to a company in**  
20                  **Tucson until a preventive maintenance program can be set up by SWMP on the**  
21                  **Nation; and**
- 22   **WHEREAS, the Program has been using a portion of the inactive construction yard, which**  
23                  **is adjacent to TOUA's Administrative and Maintenance Facility, for trash truck**  
24                  **parking since the program began in January 1998.**
- 25   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
26                  **approves the creation of a new line item, Occasional Appointments @ \$4,000.00**

1 **and modifies the program's FY-1999 budget as stated in the attached budget**  
2 **amendment.**

3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above identified new line item become part of the Solid**  
4 **Waste Management Program's base budget for FY-2000.**

6 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15TH. day of**  
7 **JULY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,863.85 FOR; -0-**  
8 **AGAINST; 79.05 NOT VOTING; and 222.6 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
9 **Council by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
10 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
11 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
12 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
