

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Rescinding Resolution No. 99-411)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-412

1 **WHEREAS, on July 26, 1999, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council held a Special**
2 **Session to address the FY 2000 Projected Revenues; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council adopted Resolution No. 99-411, Approving FY 2000**
4 **Projected Revenues in the amount of \$31,233,000; and**
5 **WHEREAS, due to the adoption of Resolution No. 99-411, the Legislative Council had**
6 **concerns on Resolution No. 99-411 which did not include amounts for Law**
7 **Enforcement and Nursing Home which will effect the total projected revenues**
8 **and District allocations.**
9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby rescind**
10 **Resolution No. 99-411.**

13 **JULY, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,547.6 FOR; 459.8**
14 **AGAINST; 158.1 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
15 **by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
16 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
17 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16**
18 **of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
