1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided preventive health care for women,
2		infants and children during Fiscal Year 1999; and
3	WHEREAS,	the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United States
4		Department of Agriculture for programs designed to benefit women, infants
5		and children; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement
7		with Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants
8		and Children (WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 1997 through
9		September 30, 2001; and
10	WHEREAS,	the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services
11		continue to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and
12		improve the health of individuals at risk.
13	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:
14		1. The Tohono O'odham Nation hereby approves the proposal for funding
15		from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and
16		provide services to eligible women, infants and children.
17		2. The Memorandum of Agreement shall continue through September 30,
18		2001.
19		3. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit, the Chairman and Vice
20		Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate
21		and execute contracts associated with this program and to expend funds
