17		O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while
18		negotiations are still be conducted and no executed grant has been approved
19		by the United States Department of Agriculture.
20	BE IT FINAI	LLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono
21		O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any
22		designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
23		provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding
24		level of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
