## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Setting Aside \$2,532,002 for Construction of a Dialysis Center and Authorizing the Chairman of the Nation to Contract for Such Services)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-443

1	WHEREAS,	out of all the causes of death, Diabetes Mellitus is 68.1 per 100,000 O'odham,
2		as compared to only 10.1 for the United States, and 29.1 for all IHS areas, thus
3		making the incidence of Diabetes Mellitus for Tohono O'odham 680% higher
4		than the overall averages for the United States; and
5	WHEREAS,	diabetes increasingly results in end stage renal disease which requires
6		dialysis treatment; and
7	WHEREAS,	Resolution 98-273, "Permitting GAMBRO Healthcare to Provide End-State
8		Renal Disease Dialysis Services on the Tohono O'odham Nation", authorizes
9		the Chairman of the Nation or his representative to "explore long-term
10		solutions to provide future ESRD Dialysis services within the Nation and to
11		enter into contracts with GAMBRO for ESRD dialysis services"; and
12	WHEREAS,	GAMBRO has submitted to the Chairman of the Nation a proposal for
13		development and construction of a dialysis facility, attached hereto and
14		incorporated by this reference, which projects a cost of \$1,417,000; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Department of Human Services has submitted a proposal for funding
16		coordination and operation of an ESRD dialysis services project at a cost of
17		\$1,115,002., including cost for: non-Dialysis space, infrastructure, parking and
18		lighting, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference; and
19	WHEREAS,	current Indian Health Service facility-providing ESRD is operating at full
20		capacity and has had to refer patients to facilities in Tucson; and
21	WHEREAS,	the District Chairmen and Districts were provided a status report which
22		included cost estimate for the construction of the Interim Dialysis facility.
23		Attached are copies of District resolutions supporting the use of Gaming
24		savings or other appropriate method of funding the construction of the
25		Interim Dialysis Facility; and

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-443** (Setting Aside \$2,532,002 for Construction of a Dialysis Center and Authorizing the Chairman of the Nation to Contract for Such Services) Page 2 of 4 the Nation intends to expend funds prior to the issuance of a proposed Bond 1 WHEREAS. obligation to acquire and install all or a portion of the project and equipment, 2 3 and expects that such expenditures will be reimbursed with proceeds of the **Bond Obligation; and** 4 to comply with the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 5 WHEREAS, amended (the "Code"), and the Treasury regulations thereunder, the 6 7 Underwriter desires that this Resolution constitute its declaration of "official 8 intent" to reimburse such expenditures with proceeds of the Bond Obligation; 9 and Reimbursement of Expenditures. The Underwriter declares its intention and 10 WHEREAS, 11 reasonable expectation to use proceeds of the Bond Obligation to reimburse the Tribe for amounts paid for the Project and Equipment prior to issuance 12 13 of the Bond Obligation. The expenditures to be reimbursed with proceeds of 14 the Bond Obligation shall constitute expenditures that are properly 15 chargeable to the Project and Equipment Purchase; and Reimbursement Period. The Bond Obligation shall be issued, and the 16 reimbursement allocation shall be made with respect to each such 17 18 expenditure, not later than 18 months after the later of (i) the date on which the expenditure is paid, or (ii) the date on which the Project and or Equipment 19 is placed in service, but in no event more than three years after the original 20 expenditure is paid; and 21 NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED that: 22 The amount of \$2,532,002.00 is hereby set aside in an income earning 23 account for the purpose of funding coordination, development and 24 construction and operation of an ESRD dialysis facility; and 25 The Chairman of the Nation is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute 26

(Setting Aside \$2,532,002 for Construction of a Dialysis Center and Authorizing the Chairman of the Nation to Contract for Such Services) Page 3 of 4 1 any and all agreements necessary for the development and construction of such a dialysis facility adjacent to the Health Complex; and 2 The Chairman of the Nation is further authorized to implement an ESRD 3 dialysis project as a project of the Executive Branch funded from the 4 5 monies set aside by this Resolution. BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorize 6 the Nation's Treasurer to transfer from the Gaming Saving Account(s) the sum 7 of \$2,532,002.00 into a new account, which account to earn investment income 8 9 in accordance with Tohono O'odham Nation investment policies, for the 10 purpose of initiating the design and construction of the Dialysis Facility 11 Project and that the interest accruing to account to retained for the purpose 12 of the Dialysis Facility Project unforeseen costs, it further authorizes the Chairman and the Treasurer to proceed and investigate the placement of the 13 **Bond Obligation.** 14 15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the  $04^{TH}$ . day of 16 AUGUST 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council 17 by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, 18 19 adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting 20 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 21 22 23 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 24 25 26 27 Dennis Ramon, Legislative Chairman 28 29 6th day of August, 19 99 30 31 32 33
