

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Transfer of Responsibility for Facilities Management from Papago
Agency to the Papago Agency Office of Indian Education Programs)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-446

1 **WHEREAS, transferring responsibility and funding for facilities management to the**
2 **schools is expected to result in improved facilities maintenance and services**
3 **more closely meeting the needs of the schools; and**

4 **WHEREAS, having facilities staff more directly involved with the education program is**
5 **expected to have a positive impact on school improvement programs; and**

6 **WHEREAS, involving facilities staff more closely with the education programs will**
7 **provide them increased opportunities for participation in the school activities**
8 **and for personal development; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Papago Agency Schools Board has determined that the**
10 **schools are prepared to accept the responsibility for direction and**
11 **supervision of the facilities program; and**

12 **WHEREAS, such direction and supervision of facilities programs is authorized under Part**
13 **B of Title XI of the Education Amendments of 1978.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**
15 **transfer of the facilities management program from the Bureau of Indian**
16 **Affairs Papago Agency to the Papago Agency Office of Indian Education**
17 **Programs, Santa Rosa Ranch School, Santa Rosa Boarding School, San Simon**
18 **School, and Tohono O'odham High School.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 05TH day of**
21 **AUGUST, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
23 **by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
24 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
25 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16**
26 **of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
