

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Amendment No. 1 to Attorney Contract with California Indian  
Legal Services)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-448**

1   **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 98-464, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved**  
2           **an Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal Services to provide legal**  
3           **representation to the Nation in connection with certain cases pending in**  
4           **California under the Indian Child Welfare Act; and**

5   **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract is in the amount of \$19,000 for fiscal year 1999; and**

6   **WHEREAS, the additional sum of \$8,000 is required for legal fees and expenses to assure**  
7           **uninterrupted legal representation for fiscal year 1999; and**

8   **WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the budget of the Office of Attorney General**  
9           **to supplement the Attorney contract by such amount; and**

10   **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval of Amendment No. 1**  
11           **to the Attorney Contract to increase the Contract amount by \$8,000.**

12   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

13           **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves Amendment**  
14           **No. 1 to the Attorney Contract with California Indian Legal Services in the**  
15           **form attached hereto, which increases the Contract amount by \$8,000**  
16           **payable from the fiscal year 1999 operating budget of the Office of**  
17           **Attorney General.**

18           **2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute**  
19           **Amendment No. 1 to such Contract.**

21   **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 05<sup>TH</sup> day of**  
22   **AUGUST, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**  
23   **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
24   **by Section 2(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**  
25   **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
26   **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16**  
27   **of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


