

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Gaming Authority's proposals for the design of a new
Gaming Facility)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-476

- 1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 93-296, the Legislative Council enacted the Ordinance for**
2 **the Regulation of Gaming Activities within the Nation, which authorizes the**
3 **conduct of gaming activities within the Nation; and**
- 4 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 93-311, the Legislative Council adopted the Charter of the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Gaming Authority as the entity of the Nation charged with**
6 **developing, operating and maintaining the Nation's gaming facilities; and**
- 7 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4(d) of the Charter of the Gaming Authority, the Gaming**
8 **Authority is required to produce the maximum economic return to the Nation**
9 **consistent with the fair and reasonable expectations of gaming activity**
10 **patrons; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 94-467, the Legislative Council directed the Gaming**
12 **Authority to develop additional class III gaming facilities within the Nation**
13 **taking into account the recommendations of the feasibility study; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, in accordance with the recommended locations presented in the feasibility**
15 **study, and the Gaming Authority's recommendation, by Resolution No. 99-467,**
16 **the Nation approved a lease of land to the Gaming Authority for the purpose**
17 **of locating a gaming facility on the Nation's trust land adjacent to Interstate**
18 **19 at the Pima Mine Road exit within the San Xavier District; and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11 of the approved lease, the Gaming Authority presented**
20 **to the Legislative Council on September 13, 1999, a general development plan**
21 **and architect's design for the complete development of the entire leased**
22 **premises, which plans and design are similar to those presented to the Nation**
23 **in 1995, upon the Legislative Council's approval of a lease for that same parcel**
24 **to the Gaming Authority by Resolution No. 95-534; and**
- 25 **WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee recommends approval of the general development**
