

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorization For Extension of Time For Grant Agreement 6-FG-32-00100;  
Internal Modification No. 07)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-477**

- 1   **WHEREAS, the Secretary of Interior bears the responsibility for completion of the designs**  
2                   **and construction of facilities for the Schuk Toak New Farm project as**  
3                   **contemplated under the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of**  
4                   **1982 (SAWRSA); and**
- 5   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did enter into a \$23.4 million, four-year Public**  
6                   **Law 93-638 Grant Agreement (6-FG-32-00100, Council Resolution No. 95-141)**  
7                   **with the Secretary of Interior, through the Bureau of Reclamation, to**  
8                   **complete the construction of facilities for the Schuk Toak New Farm project;**  
9                   **and**
- 10   **WHEREAS, the current expiration date of Grant Agreement 6-FG-32-00100 is December 31,**  
11                   **1999, and the construction and management work now scheduled cannot be**  
12                   **completed within the time remaining; and**
- 13   **WHEREAS, the Nation's Water Projects Office has assessed the work in progress and funds**  
14                   **remaining, and recommends to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that**  
15                   **the Grant Agreement be extended for an additional year, to expire on**  
16                   **December 31, 2000; and**
- 17   **WHEREAS, the work remaining under the Grant Agreement -- construction, ecological**  
18                   **mitigation and close-out activities -- can be accomplished with carry-over**  
19                   **funding from the original contract estimate of \$23.4 million, assuming that**  
20                   **funding and processing activities are completed in a timely manner**  
21                   **throughout the remainder of the current year.**
- 22   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it**  
23                   **hereby approves an extension of Grant Agreement 6-FG-32-00100, with the**  
24                   **Bureau of Reclamation, until December 31, 2000 to complete activities related**  
25                   **to construction, ecological mitigation and close-out.**

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that there will otherwise be no changes in the aggregate funding  
2 levels originally contracted, provided that any obligated or advanced funds  
3 not expended by the end of the fiscal period will carry over into, and be  
4 available throughout, the extension period.

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes  
6 and directs the Chairman of the Nation to execute, with the Bureau of  
7 Reclamation, an extension of Grant Agreement 6-FG-32-00100 until December  
8 31, 2000, and to pursue completion of construction, ecological mitigation and  
9 close-out activities.

10 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby  
11 requests the Accounting Department to identify an accurate Carry-Over  
12 amount before the end of the current fiscal period.

13 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 13TH day of**  
14 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,957.4 FOR;**  
15 **80.0 AGAINST; 128.1 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
16 **Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
17 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
18 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
19 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
