

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Pisinemo District FY 2000 Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-481

1 WHEREAS, at a regularly scheduled session of the Legislative Council, the Pisinemo District
2 did present the District operating budget for Fiscal Year 2000; and
3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did review the proposal of the
4 Pisinemo District; and
5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did determine that there was sufficient
6 funds with the Nation's Distribution of \$705,117.55 and the Pisinemo District
7 Bank Account to support this proposal; and
8 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council did approve their FY-2000 Budget through
9 Pisinemo District Council Resolution 99-22 dated August 30, 1999.
10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does
11 approve the FY-2000 operating budget of the Pisinemo District in the amount
12 of \$1,092,301.00.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 13TH day of
14 SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-
15 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
16 Section 1(d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted
17 by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
18 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
19 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
