5	WHEREAS, Indian Health Services has provided for Tribal Priority ranking on the four (4)
6	most critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall
7	prioritization of projects; and
8	WHEREAS, the Office of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided
9	recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Nation regarding the most critical
10	needs.
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation has reviewed and
12	approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following
13	deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order or
14	prioritization:
15	1. Crowhang-Comobabi Water
16	2. Sells Water & Sewer
17	3. Santa Rosa Village Water & Sewer
18	4. Vaya Chin Water & Sewer
