

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Assigning the Human Resources Development Committee as the Oversight
Committee for the Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-486

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Constitution, Article VI § 1 (a) grants to the Tohono**
2 **O'odham Legislative Council the authority to establish rules and procedures**
3 **to regulate all standing committees; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Constitution, Article VI § 1 (b) grants to the Tohono**
5 **O'odham Legislative Council the authority to establish and regulate**
6 **subordinate organizations for business purposes; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the need for Veterans**
8 **Services are limited to all Tohono O'odham veterans, who have served duty to**
9 **their country during war and peace times; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office was established by**
11 **Resolution No. 99-213; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office was not assigned an**
13 **oversight committee to review the plan of operation and recommend future**
14 **changes that will improve the services to all veterans residing on the Tohono**
15 **O'odham Nation; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has reviewed the situation and recommends that the**
17 **Legislative Council assign the Human Resources Development Committee as**
18 **the oversight committee for the Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs**
19 **Office.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 21 **1. Approves of the recommendation of the Rules Committee and assigns the**
22 **Human Resources Development Committee as the Oversight committee**
23 **for the Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 14TH day of**
25 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR;**
26 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
27 **Council by Section 1 (a) & (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
