

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing FY 2000 Expenditures from the SAWRSA Trust Fund for Continuation
of Efforts to Complete Tribal Responsibilities and Obligations Related to
Utilization of Central Arizona Project Water and Irrigation Systems)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-492

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council, by means of Resolution No. 99-334,**
2 **authorized and directed the completion of tribal responsibilities and**
3 **obligations related to construction of facilities for utilization of Central Arizona**
4 **Project water and irrigation systems in the eastern Schuk Toak District; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Water Projects Office developed projections for costs associated**
6 **with construction and administration efforts totaling \$4,809,941, and requested**
7 **from the SAWRSA Trust Fund, an amount of \$1,599,730 for the second half of FY**
8 **1999; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, portions of work originally identified for FY 1999 were not completed and are**
10 **now incorporated into FY 2000 as reflected in the attached budget and**
11 **justification; and**
- 12 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office submitted the attached budget and justification for**
13 **FY 2000 to continue the scope of work authorized under Resolution No. 99-334**
14 **for an amount of \$4,586,219; and**
- 15 **WHEREAS, the Water Projects Office requests from the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**
16 **Council, approval of funding from the SAWRSA Trust Fund to enable completion**
17 **of tribal responsibilities and obligations related to utilization of Central**
18 **Arizona Project water and irrigation systems in the eastern Schuk Toak District.**
- 19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it**
20 **hereby approves the funding request and authorizes expenditures in**
21 **accordance with the scope of work and the attached budget.**
- 22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that funds in the amount of \$4,586,219 are hereby appropriated**
23 **from the SAWRSA Trust Fund to cover expenditures during the period from**
24 **October 01, 1999 through September 30, 2000.**

4 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
5 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the
6 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
7 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


