1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 99-342, the Nation authorized submission and negotiation
2		of the Fiscal Year 2000 Annual Funding Agreement and Contract Amendment
3		to the Indian Self-Determination Act Master Contract with the Bureau of
4		Indian Affairs; and
5	WHEREAS,	Resolution No.99-342 excluded the Adult Detention Center from the Fiscal Year
6		2000 Annual Funding Agreement and Contract Amendment; and
7	WHEREAS,	negotiations with the Bureau of Indian Affairs have led to the conclusion that
8		it is in the best interest of the Nation to retain the operation of the Adult
9		Detention Center under the control of the Nation; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Nation now asserts an intent to operate the Adult Detention Center for one
11		additional year pursuant to the Fiscal Year 2000 Annual Funding Agreement
12		and Contract Amendment, provided that the Bureau of Indian Affairs agrees
13		to assist the Nation in meaningful ways to provide for the expansion needs of
14		the Adult Detention Center and to give the Bureau's best efforts to improve the
15		condition of the facility.
16	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:
17		1. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to negotiate an
18		Annual Funding Agreement for FY 2000 and an Amendment to the Master
19		Contract which provide for the Nation to operate the Adult Detention
20		Facility under the Annual Funding Agreement and the Master Contract.
21		2. Resolution No. 99-342 is hereby amended to include as a term and
22		condition of the Fiscal Year 2000 Annual Funding Agreement that the
23		Nation retain the operation of the Adult Detention Center under the

control of the Nation, and to authorize the Chairman to negotiate

maximum funding and acceptance by the Bureau of the terms by which the Nation shall retain the operation of the Adult Detention Center under the control of the Nation.

- 3. Paragraph 1(E) of the Fiscal Year 2000 Annual Funding Agreement, attached to Res. No. 99-342, is hereby amended to read as follows: "General Law Enforcement Services, which shall include the provision of general law enforcement and police services, detention, and the Ranger Program."
- 4. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to negotiate extensions of the current Annual Funding Agreement and Master Contract should the status of Congressional appropriations or the status of negotiations with the Bureau of Indian Affairs warrant such an extension.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 16TH. day of <u>SEPTEMBER</u>, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.957.4 FOR; -0-AGAINST; 208.1 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
