(Supporting the Effort of the Cultural Affairs Office and the Cultural Center/
Museum Committee to Obtain Grant Funding from the Administration for
Native Americans to Assist in the Planning and Designing of a Cultural
Center/Museum for the Tohono O'odham Nation)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-499

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has provided budget support for the**
2 **Cultural Affairs Office and the Tohono O'odham Cultural Center/Museum**
3 **Committee to plan and design a Cultural Center/Museum for the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation for the past two fiscal years and plans to do so for FY 2000; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the concept of a Cultural**
6 **Center/Museum for the Tohono O'odham Nation and plans to support the**
7 **design and construction costs of this Cultural Center/Museum in the future.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council strongly**
9 **supports and endorses the efforts of the Cultural Affairs Office and Cultural**
10 **Center/Museum Committee to obtain grant funding from the Administration**
11 **for Native Americans to support the Nation's efforts to design and build a**
12 **Cultural Center/Museum for the Tohono O'odham Nation.**

13 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 16TH day of**
14 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165,5 FOR; -0-**
15 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
16 **Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
17 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
18 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
19 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




