1 **WHEREAS, Chukut Kuk District Council met on September 11, 1999 in Vamori at which a**
2 **quorum was present; and**
3 **WHEREAS, the FY 2000 district budget was presented for review; and**
4 **WHEREAS, the district Budget Committee did review the budget which was developed to**
5 **address the needs of Chukut Kuk District; and**
6 **WHEREAS, Chukut Kuk District Council did approve the Chukut Kuk District Budget and**
7 **Justification for FY 2000 in the amount of \$984,276.38.**
8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**
9 **the Chukut Kuk District Budget for FY 2000 in the amount of \$984,276.38.**

10 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH day of**
11 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR; -0-**
12 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
13 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted**
14 **by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
15 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of**
16 **the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


