

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 99 Second Amended Conflict Attorney Contract for
David M. Juarez)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-511

1 **WHEREAS, the Advocate Program requires the services of conflict attorneys to provide**
2 **representation to members which cannot be represented by the Program due**
3 **to an ethical conflict of interest; and**

4 **WHEREAS, on April 9, 1999, Resolution No. 99-147 was passed by the Legislative Council**
5 **authorizing the Chairman of the Nation to enter into a contract with David M.**
6 **Juarez, Esq. (Attorney), and other attorneys, to provide legal services in the**
7 **amount of \$20,000.00 for FY'99; and**

8 **WHEREAS, on July 18, 1999, Resolution No. 99-380 was passed by the Legislative Council**
9 **authorizing the Chairman of the Nation to enter into an amended contract with**
10 **David M. Juarez, Esq. (Attorney) increasing allowable fees and expenses under**
11 **the original contract to \$27,000.00; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the projected amount of fees and expenses incurred by Attorney in FY'99 will**
13 **exceed the contract amount by \$5,000; and**

14 **WHEREAS, a second of Attorney's contract is necessary and appropriate to authorize**
15 **compensation to Attorney by the Nation beyond the amended contracted**
16 **amount of \$27,000.00.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

18 **Paragraph 3, Section C of the contract entered into by Attorney and the**
19 **Chairman of the Nation on April 14, 1998 is hereby amended as follows:**

7 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
8 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of**
9 **the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


