	obtain information on the O'odham in Mexico, also the health fair would allow			
	the Nation and Indian Health Service to conduct the Focus Group Study for the			
	${\bf purpose}\ of\ developing\ a\ survey\ instrument\ for\ door\ to\ door\ health\ assessment;$

WHEREAS,	Indian Health Services (IHS) agreed to provide funds in the amount of twenty			
	thousand dollars (\$22,550) to support/assist the Nation in participating in the			
	Trinational Health Fair, scheduled for October 15, 1999 in Sonoyta, Mexico; and			
WHEREAS,	the Human Services did prepare a budget in support of the Nation to participate			
	in the Trinational Health Fair in Sonoyta, Mexico.			
NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby accepts funds in the			
	amount of \$22,550 provided by Indian Health Service to assist the Nation in			
	participating in the Trinational Health Fair, scheduled for October 15, 1999 in			
	Sonoyta, Mexico.			
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the attached budget in the				
	amount of twenty two thousand five hundred fifty dollars (\$22,550) for the
