

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorization to Continue Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branch Operations)

DEFEATED
RESOLUTION NO. 99-524

1 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee wishes to forward the FY 2000 Budgets**
2 **with clear justification documenting the current availability of the Nation's**
3 **revenue for the FY 2000 period; and**

4 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches to**
5 **continue its fiscal operations pending the review and approval of its FY 2000**
6 **budgets by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

7 **WHEREAS, in order that programs and services provided will not be interrupted, the**
8 **Budget and Finance Committee is requesting an extension not to exceed six (6)**
9 **months to address the FY 2000 Budgets.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does**
11 **hereby authorize the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branches to continue**
12 **operations at current spending levels in order that programs and services will**
13 **not be interrupted.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this interim period will not exceed March 01, 2000.**


15 **The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the**
16 **23RD. Day of SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present, and by a vote**
17 **of 873.25 FOR; 1,292.25 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, failed to pass because**
18 **it did not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2 of Article V of the**
19 **Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation.**
