

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Re-Authorization of the Judiciary Branch FY 99 Appropriation Funds for FY 2000;  
Authorization of Expenditures)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-527**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 99 Judicial Branch**  
2 **budget by Resolution No. 99-526, thereby, authorizing the appropriated funds**  
3 **for expenditure by the Judiciary; and**

4 **WHEREAS, that involved the construction phase of the Boy's Home. This project will not be**  
5 **completed until approximately the last week in November, 1999. These**  
6 **circumstances have delayed the Judiciary's time scheduled for completion of**  
7 **this project; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the delay in the construction and finalizing the boy's home which include the**  
9 **renovation and construction of the existing boy's and girl's home, along with the**  
10 **school facility project, from being completed in FY 99. Consequently, this**  
11 **project is expected to be completed in November, 1999; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Branch is committed to the completion of these projects, which**  
13 **require additional authorization for expenditures in FY 2000, requests that**  
14 **these projects be re-authorized; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the funds for FY 99 identified for these projects in the amount of \$673,645.00**  
16 **have not been re-obligated and remain restricted and available for the purpose**  
17 **in which they were funded and intended for; and**

18 **WHEREAS, any remaining balance existing after the completion of this project will be**  
19 **reverted to the Nation's general funds.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**  
21 **attached budget, Tohono O'odham Judiciary Branch Request for Re-**  
22 **Authorization for FY 99 Appropriation Funds, is hereby approved as submitted**  
23 **and is authorized to be expended accordingly.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the balances and amounts identified by the attached**  
25 **budget, totaling \$673,645, are hereby re-authorized.**

6 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
7 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


