RESOLUTION NO. 99-533

1 **WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee has submitted a budget for consideration by the**
2 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for purposes of attending meetings with**
3 **the State, National Indian Gaming Association (NIGA), and other Indian gaming**
4 **related conference and/or meetings; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee Twelve-Month Budget submitted in the amount of**
6 **\$70,500.00 is effective October 01, 1999 to September 30, 2000; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the budget will be made part of the Operating Expense of Desert Diamond**
8 **Casino.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**
10 **hereby approves the Commerce Committee Twelve Month Budget in the**
11 **amount of \$70,500.00.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29TH day of**
13 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,292.25 FOR;**
14 **794.2 AGAINST; 79.05 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
15 **Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**
16 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the**
17 **Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant**
18 **to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




