

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Attorney Contract with Law Firm of Korn, Waterman & Simon)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-536**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has a continued need for legal Advice**  
2 **and representation on matters in which the Office of Attorney General has a**  
3 **conflict of interest or the Attorney General has insufficient resources to provide**  
4 **the legal services requested; and**

5 **WHEREAS, an Attorney Contract with the law firm of Korn, Waterman & Simon has been**  
6 **proposed to secure the legal services not available through the Office of**  
7 **Attorney General for the foregoing reasons, a copy of which is attached hereto;**  
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, the approved budget of the Legislative Council for Fiscal Year 2000 has available**  
10 **funding sufficient to pay all fees and expenses under the Attorney Contract; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees did review the**  
12 **Contract and recommends for approval.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 14 **1. The Attorney Contract with the law firm of Korn, Waterman & Simon is**  
15 **hereby approved by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council in the form**  
16 **attached hereto, in the amount of \$65,000 for the period from October 1,**  
17 **1999 through September 30, 2000.**
- 18 **2. All fees and expenses incurred under the Attorney Contract shall be payable**  
19 **from the approved budget of the Legislative Council for Fiscal Year 2000.**
- 20 **3. The Chairman of the Legislative Council and the Chairman of the Nation are**  
21 **authorized and directed to execute the Attorney Contract.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29TH, day of**  
23 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,120.45 FOR;**  
24 **901.95 AGAINST; 143.1 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
25 **Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
26 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
27 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
28 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


