

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Continuing Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2000 to Fund Activities  
Authorized Under Resolution No. 98-290)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-538**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 98-290, the Nation approved an appropriation from savings**  
2 **set aside from gaming revenues to fund intergovernmental and public**  
3 **relations; and**

4 **WHEREAS, it is in the interests of the Nation to continue funding the activities authorized**  
5 **by Resolution No. 98-290 pending approval of a budget for such activities for**  
6 **fiscal year 2000.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT :**

- 8 **1. There is hereby appropriated from savings set aside from gaming**  
9 **revenues such sums as may be necessary to continue those activities**  
10 **authorized by Resolution No. 98-290, at the rate authorized by Resolution**  
11 **No. 98-290.**
- 12 **2. Appropriations and funds made available and authority granted, for**  
13 **fiscal year 2000 pursuant to this Resolution for those activities**  
14 **authorized by Resolution No. 98-290, shall be available until such time**  
15 **as the Legislative Council approves a budget for such activities for fiscal**  
16 **year 2000.**
- 17 **3. Expenditures made pursuant to this continuing Resolution shall be**  
18 **charged to the applicable line item of the fiscal year 2000 budget when**  
19 **such budget is approved by the Legislative Council.**
- 20 **4. Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement with Joseph F. Abate, in the form**  
21 **attached hereto, is hereby approved.**
- 22 **5. Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract with Oldaker & Harris, in the**  
23 **form attached hereto, is hereby approved.**
- 24 **6. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the above-**  
25 **referenced amendments and to take such other reasonable and appropriate**  
26 **steps as may be necessary to implement this Resolution.**

3 634.2 AGAINST; 160.0 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
4 Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham  
5 Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the  
6 Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
7 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
