7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:					
8	1. It hereby approves a Health Transportation Services Division under the					
9	Department of Human Services to be established to manage and administer					
10	the health transportation services.					
11	2. It hereby approves the attached budget as submitted.					
12	3. Approve the remaining balance of the \$565,972.55 allocated in the FY 1999					
13	budget of \$1,325,100.00 to be carried over into the FY 2000 as part of the					
14	Health Transportation budget.					
15	4. Approve the remaining balance of the IC 007 account to be utilized to cover					
16	operational cost for the Health Transportation Services budget.					
17	5. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice					
18	Chairman and any designated Official is hereby authorized to negotiate and					
19	execute the contracts and expend funds associated with this budget.
