

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of FY 2000 Department of Human Services - Division of Health  
Transportation Services Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-544**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation desires to provide medically necessary**  
2 **transportation to members regardless of ability to pay; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation desires to collect any and all third party**  
4 **reimbursements to provide medically necessary transportation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, a health transportation services budget in the amount of \$1,745,839.00 is**  
6 **submitted to implement medically necessary transportation services.**

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 8 **1. It hereby approves a Health Transportation Services Division under the**  
9 **Department of Human Services to be established to manage and administer**  
10 **the health transportation services.**
- 11 **2. It hereby approves the attached budget as submitted.**
- 12 **3. Approve the remaining balance of the \$565,972.55 allocated in the FY 1999**  
13 **budget of \$1,325,100.00 to be carried over into the FY 2000 as part of the**  
14 **Health Transportation budget.**
- 15 **4. Approve the remaining balance of the IC 007 account to be utilized to cover**  
16 **operational cost for the Health Transportation Services budget.**
- 17 **5. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice**  
18 **Chairman and any designated Official is hereby authorized to negotiate and**  
19 **execute the contracts and expend funds associated with this budget.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 30TH day of**  
21 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,199.5 FOR;**  
22 **966.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
23 **Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham**  
24 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the**  
25 **Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant**  
26 **to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


