

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(In support of the FY 2000 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation**  
**Program Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-547**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded funding from the U.S. Department**  
2 **of Education, Section 121 Grant No. H250G980011 to implement a Vocational**  
3 **Rehabilitation Program on the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, services will be provided to eligible American Indians with Disabilities under**  
5 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program who reside**  
6 **on or near the Tohono O'odham Nation with enrolled Tohono O'odham**  
7 **members being first priority; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the services provided will be consistent with individual strengths, resources,**  
9 **priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities and informed choice of eligible**  
10 **American Indians so that they may prepare for and engage in gainful**  
11 **employment.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports**  
13 **the FY 2000 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation**  
14 **Program budget in the amount of \$327,068.00.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono**  
16 **O'odham Nation's officials, the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any**  
17 **designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 30<sup>TH</sup> day of**  
19 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR;**  
20 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
21 **Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
22 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
23 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
24 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
