

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adoption of the Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office FY 2000 budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-555

1 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has prepared and presented its Fiscal Year 2000 budget**
2 **to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch FY 2000 budget funds regular department and program**
4 **operations, and has been prepared to reflect the market and longevity for all**
5 **Executive Branch employees as authorized by the Council; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Veteran's Affairs Office (TONVAO) was established**
7 **as a permanent program of the Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council assigned the TONVAO to the Human**
9 **Resources Development Committee of the Council; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the TONVAO has prepared an FY 2000 budget for approval by the Tohono**
11 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
13 **TONVAO FY 2000 budget is hereby approved.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding in the amount of \$128,474.40 be appropriated from**
15 **sources approved by this Council for support of the FY 2000 budgets of the**
16 **Tohono O'odham Nation.**

17 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the TONVAO be included and be made a permanent**
18 **program of the Executive Branch.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 30TH day of**
21 **SEPTEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,165.5 FOR;**
22 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
23 **Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
24 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
25 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**
26 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
