

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 1999 Department of Human Services/Division of Community
Health Services - Elder Health Care Initiative Budget Modification #5)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-582

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently developing a Home Health Agency**
2 **under IHS Grant #ISH002103-02 with the Indian Health Services; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, through Resolution No. 97-265, approved a five year**
4 **project and year two budget in the amount of \$189,050.00; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, through Resolution No. 98-500, approved the use of**
6 **Project Year 1 (FY 98) carryover funds in Project Year 2 (FY 99); and**

7 **WHEREAS, there is a continued need for coordinated, comprehensive delivery of basic**
8 **Home Health Care to frail and disabled elders in their home on the Tohono**
9 **O'odham Nation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, a budget modification is submitted for review to continue the development of**
11 **a Home Health Agency.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 13 **1. It hereby approves the reallocation of approved funds between line items in**
14 **the Elder Initiative Budget.**
- 15 **2. It hereby approves the Elder Health Care Initiative, Budget Modification #5**
16 **as submitted.**
- 17 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice**
18 **Chairman and any designated Official is hereby authorized to negotiate and**
19 **execute contracts associated with this grant and to expend funds when**
20 **received.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH**
22 **of OCTOBER 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,865.6 FOR; -0-**
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 299.9 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
24 **Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**
25 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
26 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**
27 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


