

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Attorney Contract with the Law Firm of Slosser, Hudgins, Struse & Freund)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-595

1 **WHEREAS, an Initiative, No. IN-01-97 (the "Initiative"), was approved by the voters of the**
2 **Tohono O'odham Nation on June 28, 1997; and**

3 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolutions 98-468 and 99-058, the Nation**
4 **entered into an Attorney Contract, and Amendment No.1 thereto, with the law**
5 **firm of Raven & Kirschner to assist the Office of Attorney General in assessing**
6 **the tax implications for the Nation and its members associated with the**
7 **implementation of the Initiative; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 1999; and**

9 **WHEREAS, continued representation is necessary to protect the Nation's interests in these**
10 **matters; and**

11 **WHEREAS, Susan M. Freund was the attorney at Raven & Kirschner who provided the tax**
12 **advice under the Attorney Contract for fiscal year 1999; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Ms. Freund has joined the firm of Slosser, Hudgins, Struse & Freund; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General recommends that such firm (the "Attorneys") be engaged**
15 **for representation in fiscal year 2000; and**

16 **WHEREAS, an Initiative Legal Research budget (the "Budget") in the amount of \$50,000**
17 **(Account No. 24-1809-810) was approved for fiscal year 2000 for legal costs**
18 **associated with implementation of the Initiative; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has recommended an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys**
20 **for fiscal year 2000 in the amount of \$20,000; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative**
22 **Council of an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

24 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney**
25 **Contract with the law firm of Slosser, Hudgins, Struse & Freund, in the form**
26 **attached hereto, in the amount of \$20,000 for fiscal year 2000.**

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- 2. **Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the Initiative Legal Research budget (24-1809-810).**
- 3. **The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney Contract.**




