12		advice under the Attorney Contract for fiscal year 1999; and
13	WHEREAS,	Ms. Freund has joined the firm of Slosser, Hudgins, Struse & Freund; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Attorney General recommends that such firm (the "Attorneys") be engaged
15		for representation in fiscal year 2000; and
16	WHEREAS,	an Initiative Legal Research budget (the "Budget") in the amount of \$50,000
17		(Account No. 24-1809-810) was approved for fiscal year 2000 for legal costs
18		associated with implementation of the Initiative; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Attorney General has recommended an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys
20		for fiscal year 2000 in the amount of \$20,000; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative
22		Council of an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.
