

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Attorney Contract with Law Firm of Williams, Janov & Cooney)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-596**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution 98-465 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved an**  
2 **Attorney Contract with the law firm of Williams, Janov & Cooney (the**  
3 **"Attorneys") to provide legal representation with respect to certain of the**  
4 **Nation's water matters; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 1999; and**

6 **WHEREAS, continued representation regarding water matters is required to protect the**  
7 **Nation's interests; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has recommended an extension of the Attorney Contract**  
9 **for fiscal year 2000 in the amount of \$10,000; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the operating budget of the Office of Attorney General for fiscal year 2000**  
11 **includes sufficient funding for the Contract; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative**  
13 **Council of an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

15 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney**  
16 **Contract with the law firm of Williams, Janov & Cooney in the amount of**  
17 **\$10,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000 and in the form**  
18 **attached hereto.**

19 **2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the operating**  
20 **budget of the Office of Attorney General for fiscal year 2000.**

21 **3. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the**  
22 **Attorney Contract.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15<sup>TH</sup> day of**  
24 **OCTOBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,547.2 FOR; 160.0**  
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 458.3 [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**  
26 **Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation,**  
27 **adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**  
28 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**  
29 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
