

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Allow interested parties to submit written comments within 30 days in the "Delma Garcia Matter" and to table the resolutions until the January 2000 General Session)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 99-602

1 **WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council presented their**
2 **findings and recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the**
3 **"Delma Garcia Matter," pursuant to Legislative Order No. 99-394; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the TERO Commissioners present disputed the Judiciary Committee's interpretation**
5 **of what occurred at the TERO Commission meeting of June 01, 1999.**

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council allow**
7 **interested parties to submit written comments within 30 days in the "Delma Garcia**
8 **matter" to become part of the record.**

9 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed resolutions be tabled and referred to the**
10 **appropriate committees for their review and to bring forth during the January 2000**
11 **General Session.**

12 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH Day of**
13 **NOVEMBER, 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,401.8 FOR; 222.15**
14 **AGAINST; 541.55 NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
15 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
16 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
17 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
18 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
