

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 99 Budget Modification #1 Request for the Tohono O'odham
Nation Fire Department Wildland Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 99-605

1 **WHEREAS, the Fire Department/Department of Public Safety has taken over operations of**
2 **the Wildland Program from Bureau of Indian Affairs and will continue to**
3 **operate the program indefinitely; and**

4 **WHEREAS, funding has been provided by BIA Wildland PL-93-638 cost contract for the**
5 **operation of the Wildland Program; and**

6 **WHEREAS, this funding is to be utilized to provide emergency services in the saving of lives,**
7 **property, and protection of natural resources and wildlife to the members of**
8 **the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Fire Department/Department of Public Safety requests approval of a**
10 **modification from Wildland Program PL-93-638 FY 99 Budget; and**

11 **WHEREAS, FY 99 budget line item 10-1095-750 \$114,341.69 were unspent due to delay in**
12 **approving of the Wildland Program FY 99 budget and the considerable amount**
13 **of funds needed to be spent; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department was in the process of hiring the**
15 **Fire Management Officer to establish and manage the daily operations of the**
16 **Wildland Program; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the request of approved budget modification has been reviewed by the**
18 **appropriate Committees.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
20 **recommends approval of budget modification #1 for the Wildland Program PL-**
21 **93-638 FY 99 budget to the FY 2000 line item 10-1095-750 in the amount of**
22 **\$114,341.69.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the**
24 **16TH, day of NOVEMBER 1999 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of**
25 **2,101.452 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 64.05 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers**
26 **vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono**
27 **O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and**
28 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March**
29 **6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


